Background

The idea to write a public report highlighting solutions arose from an announcement made a speaker on panel of the Energy Institute's 2008 Annual Depletion conference, warning the audience that much of the UK's nitrogen fertiliser production had shut down and left the UK due to rising natural gas prices during 2008.
